

Science of Teaching Reading Exam

The Science of Teaching Reading exam is targeted at classroom teachers of early learners (prekindergarten - grade 6). It is designed to assess whether the examinee is proficient in the science of teaching reading standards and has obtained the requisite knowledge and skills to practice teaching early reading.

The Science of Teaching Reading module is designed to prepare you for the constructed response question on the exam and is required for your test approval. It is recommended that you complete the STR - Reading Safari class series before completing this course.

Before you will be approved for the first attempt at the Science of Teaching Reading exam, you must complete the following:

- 1. Module 1 Section 1
- 2. STR Reading Safari class series
- 3. Science of Teaching Reading module
- 4. Pass the practice test within the study material provided with at least 88%
- 5. Notify your program specialist upon completion of your requirements to request test approval.

Requirements must be completed in the order listed. Candidates will be eligible for access to the study material for 60 days once curriculum requirements for approval are complete.

You must schedule your exam within 30 days and test within 2 months of completing the test approval requirements or your approval will be removed until you can again achieve the required score on the practice test to demonstrate continued proficiency.
