

Pedagogy and Professional Responsibilities (PPR) Exam

The Pedagogy and Professional Responsibilities (PPR) exam is (for most) the second certification test you will take to become a certified teacher in the state of Texas. The PPR encompasses teacher ethics and proper classroom techniques to promote equality/fairness in the classroom.

Before you will be approved for the first attempt at the content exam, you must complete the following:

- 1. All 3 sections of Module 1
- 2. Pre-Service class series
- 3. Pass the practice test within the study material provided with at least 88%
- 4. Notify your program specialist upon completion of your requirements to request test approval.

Requirements must be completed in the order listed. Candidates will be eligible for access to the study material for 60 days once curriculum requirements for approval are complete.

You must schedule your exam within 30 days and test within 2 months of completing the test approval requirements or your approval will be removed until you can again achieve the required score on the practice test to demonstrate continued proficiency.
